

## Transforming and Modernizing the Delivery of Ontario's Building Code Services

---

The government is proposing an administrative authority to transform the delivery of a suite of new and enhanced services to support the Building sector. Transformation will help streamline customer service and approval processes, promote a consistent approach to using the Building Code, and promote public safety for all people across Ontario.

The government is considering changes to:

- Strengthen public safety
- Streamline customer service and approval processes
- Deliver sector-driven services
- Provide timely, modern tools and products
- Promote consistency across the Province
- Enhance integrity in the system

To ensure efficient, streamlined and sector-driven delivery of services the administrative authority would be financially self-sustaining and would operate on a full cost-recovery basis.

**To do this, the administrative authority would charge fees for directly delivered services and collect a small levy that is calculated on estimated construction value on top of the municipal building permit fees.**
