

PERMANENT OR SEASONAL (NON-RESIDENT) ELECTORS

ARE YOU QUALIFIED?

This information is provided as a guide to assist electors to determine their eligibility to be added to the Voters' List. All questions should be directed to the Municipal Clerk.

ALL VOTERS MUST BE A CANADIAN CITIZEN AND AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD

YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO BE ADDED TO THE VOTERS' LIST

Resident or Spouse of Resident with proof of qualifying address?
Spouse is required to provide proof of relationship with resident to establish legitimate connection to the qualifying address.*

Property Owner or Spouse of Property Owner with proof of qualifying address?
Spouse is required to provide proof of relationship with owner to establish legitimate connection to the qualifying property.*
You are not eligible if the property is owned by a Trust / Corporation

Tenant with proof of qualifying address and tenancy/rental agreement?
Tenancy/Rental must be for at least 6 weeks of the calendar year of the election.

YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO BE ADDED TO THE VOTERS' LIST

Individuals who want to be added to the Voters' List are required to show proof of identification to the satisfaction of the Clerk.

*Proof of relationship can include, but is not limited to, a marriage certificate, income tax filing, joint bill, etc.

THE DECISION OF THE CLERK IS FINAL
