PURPOSE

The purpose of the 2025 First Quarter Financial Update Report is to lay out a quarterly reporting schedule for the year and to provide Committee with an update on 2025 First Quarter financial performance against budget.

BACKGROUND

Administration report quarterly to Committee on financial performance against budget. The schedule below identifies the reports that Administration envisions will be forthcoming over the next 12 months.

ANALYSIS

The net budget for the Town to the end of Q1 2025 is 28% expended (Q1 2024 - 22% expended) and overall operating departments are in line with quarterly spending. A few departments are slightly over budget, some due to timing of expected revenue and others due to higher than anticipated expenses in the first quarter. Notably, the contracted services in Road Maintenance and Parking lots are overspent due to more frequent snow clearing and removal costs. Barring unforeseen circumstances, it is anticipated the Town will continue to track within budget to year-end and adjust as necessary.

Report to: Committee of the Whole

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Administration is closely monitoring inflationary pressure points in comparison to the calculations used to compose the 2025 Budget. Administration is also monitoring the effects on our procurement resulting from the tariffs imposed by the US. The Municipal Finance Officers Association (MFOA) and the Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO) are providing support in the way of information and updates to the information that is changing frequently. The Town is also doing its own internal analysis to assess the impact tariffs may have on our buying. As has been the practice, departments will make internal adjustments in-year as required and the Senior Leadership Team (SLT) will endeavour to ensure that we come within budget at year end. As is always the case, Administration aims to achieve savings throughout the year in operational and capital programming so we are able to achieve an appropriate degree of surplus that then helps fund capital and operating reserves.
