

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GRAVENHURST

BY-LAW NO. 2025-70

Being a By-law to Regulate Parking within the Town of Gravenhurst

WHEREAS Section 8 and 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001 c.25, as amended provides that a municipality may pass By-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS Section 63 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. c. 25, as amended, authorizes that, where a municipality passes a by-law for prohibiting or regulating the placing, stopping, standing, or parking of an object or vehicle on a Highway, it may provide for the removal and impounding or retraining and immobilizing of any object or vehicle placed, stopped, standing or parked on a highway in contravention of the by-law;

AND WHEREAS Section 102 (2) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. c. 25, provides that a municipality may require owners and operators of public parking lots or facilities to provide designated spaces for vehicles displaying an accessible parking permit;

AND WHEREAS Section 427 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. c. 25, as amended, a By-law establishing a system of accessible parking shall provide that every person who contravenes the by-law shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine;

AND WHEREAS Section 425, 428 and 429 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, authorizes the creation of offenses and the imposition of liability of the owner of a vehicle left parked, stopped or standing in contravention of such by-law, and for the payment of penalties out of court;

AND WHERE section 7.1 of the Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997, S.O. 1997, c.4 authorizes by-laws designating private roads as fire routes along which no parking of motor vehicles shall be permitted and providing for the removal and impounding of any vehicle parked or left along any of the fire routes at the expense of the owner of the vehicle;

AND WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act R.S. O. 1990, c. H. 8, Section 170 (15) authorizes a police officer, police cadet, municipal law enforcement officer or an officer appointed for carrying out of the provisions of this Act, upon discovery of any vehicle parked or standing in contravention of subsection (12), of a regulation made under subsection 26(3) of the *Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c P.50 or a municipal by-law, may cause it to be moved or taken to and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for the removal, care and storage of the vehicle, if any, are a lien upon the vehicle, which may be enforced in the manner provided by the *Repair and Storage Liens Act* 2005, c. 26, Sch. A, s. 28 (2).

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Gravenhurst deem it expedient to provide for a single by-law to regulate parking and stopping within the limits of the Town of Gravenhurst;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GRAVENHURST ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1 SHORT TITLE: This by-law shall be known as the “**Parking Control By-law**”.

2 APPLICATION

2.1 This By-law applies to:

- (a) Municipal Highways;
- (b) Municipal Lots;
- (c) Municipal property;
- (d) Municipal Facilities

3 DEFINITIONS

3.1. Abandoned means a vehicle that:

- a) is unlicensed;
- b) is uninsured;
- c) does not display valid license plates;
- d) is deemed in poor condition, an obvious state of disrepair, damaged or inoperable;
- e) has been parked in excess of 24 hours of an authorized tow notice being affixed to the vehicle.

3.2 Accessible Parking Permits means a valid permit issued by the Minister of Transportation under Section 26 of the Highway Traffic Act R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8 or a valid permit, license plate or other marker or device bearing the international symbol of access issued by a jurisdiction other than Ontario;

3.3 Accessible Parking Sign means an official sign designed as per Section 11 of R.R.O. 1990, Reg. 581: Accessible Parking For Persons With Disabilities;

3.4 Accessible Parking Space means a parking space marked by an official sign as described within R.R.O. 1990, Reg. 581: Accessible Parking for Persons With Disabilities;

3.5 Angled Parking means parking a vehicle at an angle, typically 45 degrees or 60 degrees, to the curb or parking space lines, rather than parallel to the curb;

3.6 Boardwalk means a walk path typically constructed of planking;

3.7 Boulevard means that portion of the highway located between the edge of the roadway and property line of the highway which may include the untraveled portion of any highway, grassed/graveled or paved area, ditches, sidewalks and paved paths;

3.8 Bus means a motor vehicle designed for carrying ten or more passengers and used for the transportation of persons;

3.9 Bus Stand means a designated location where a bus or coach may park while out of

service between scheduled public and/or private services;

- 3.10 **Commercial Vehicle** means a motor vehicle having a registered gross vehicle weight of 4500 kgs or more;
- 3.11 **Corner** means the intersecting angle point of the curbs, except where there is no curb, the corner is defined as the intersecting angle point of the edge of the pavement or traveled portion of gravel surface, as the case may be;
- 3.12 **Crosswalk** means a specially paved or marked path for people walking across a street or road and includes a walk path;
- 3.13 **Deeded Parking Space** means a parking space that comes with a legal deed, granting the owner exclusive ownership rights to that specific parking spot;
- 3.14 **Designated Fire Route** means a Fire-Route designated, by By-law;
- 3.15 **Designated Parking Space** means an area for the temporary parking, stopping or storage of a vehicle as described within the Schedules that form part of this By-law;
- 3.16 **District Highway** means a highway owned and operated by the District of Muskoka;
- 3.17 **Downtown Core** means the areas highlighted in Schedule “J” attached hereto;
- 3.18 **Driveway** means private area in front of a house or other building onto which you can drive and park your car;
- 3.19 **EV Charging Station** means a device that delivers electrical power from the grid to an electric vehicle (EV) for recharging its battery, also known as Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE);
- 3.20 **Ministry of Transportation (MTO) Highway** means a highway owned and operated by the Minister of Transportation;
- 3.21 **Motor Vehicle** includes an automobile, a motorcycle, a motor assisted bicycle unless otherwise indicated within the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8, and any other vehicle propelled or driven otherwise than by muscular power, but does not include a street car or other motor vehicle running only upon rails, a power-assisted bicycle, a motorized snow vehicle, a traction engine, a farm tractor, a self-propelled implement of husbandry or a road-building machine; are only permitted to load or unload passengers or merchandise;
- 3.22 **Municipal Facility** means a physical location, structure or piece of infrastructure that is owned, operated or managed by the Town of Gravenhurst;
- 3.23 **Municipal Highway** means a highway owned, operated or managed by the Town of Gravenhurst;
- 3.24 **Municipal Parking Lot** means a parking lot owned, operated or managed by the Town

of Gravenhurst;

- 3.25 **Municipal Property** means land owned, operated or managed by the Town of Gravenhurst;
- 3.26 **No Standing** means a restricted portion of a Highway, municipal lot, or designated area where drivers are only permitted to receive and discharge passengers;
- 3.27 **No Stopping** means a restricted portion of a Highway, municipal lot, or designated area, where drivers are generally not permitted to stop for any reason except to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a constable or other police officer or of a traffic control sign or signal;
- 3.28 **Off Road Vehicle** means a vehicle that may include single rider, two-up and side-by-side ATV's and other utility terrain vehicles;
- 3.29 **Official Sign** means a sign in conformity with the Highway Traffic Act Regulations or approved by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications or approved by the Director of Infrastructure;
- 3.30 **Pedestrian** means a person on foot, including a person in a wheelchair;
- 3.31 **Pedestrian Crossover** means any portion of a roadway distinctly indicated for pedestrian crossing by signs on the highway and lines or other markings on the surface of the roadway as prescribed by the regulations;
- 3.32 **Person With a Disability** means any person who falls under the definition of having a disability as set out in the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005, R.S.O. 2005, c.11 as amended and the Ontario Human Rights Code;
- 3.33 **Private Road** means any private road, lane, ramp or other means of vehicular access to or from a building or structure and may include part of a parking lot;
- 3.34 **Prohibited Area** means a designated parking space or area deemed to be prohibited for a use by the Town indicated by an official sign or ground markings including but not limited to hash line, or images;
- 3.35 **Recreational Vehicle** means boats, trailers, snowmobiles, personal watercraft, and any vehicle which contains cooking and/or sleeping facilities, or which is capable of providing accommodation facilities to one or more persons and includes off road vehicles;
- 3.36 **Towing**, subject to the regulations, includes:
 - (a) the transportation of motor vehicles using a tow truck;
 - (b) any ancillary activity such as lifting a motor vehicle for the purposes of loading, towing or transporting it or placing it onto a truck or trailer for the purpose of towing or transporting; and
 - (c) any other prescribed activity.

- 3.37 Trail** means a Town designated path or route identified by an official sign;
- 3.38 Trailer** means a vehicle that is at any time drawn upon a highway by a motor vehicle, except an implement of husbandry, a mobile home, another motor vehicle or any device or apparatus not designed to transport persons or property, temporarily drawn, propelled or moved upon such highway, and except a side car attached to a motorcycle, and shall be considered a separate vehicle and not part of the motor vehicle by which it is drawn;
- 3.39 Vehicle** includes any motor vehicle, trailer, traction engine, farm tractor, road building machine and any vehicle drawn, propelled or driven by any kind or power, including muscular power, and including a motorcycle, motor assisted bicycle, motorized snow vehicle and recreational vehicle;

4 GENERAL PARKING/STOPPING PROVISIONS

- 4.1** No person shall stop/stand or park a vehicle:
- (a) Obstructing the flow of traffic;
 - (b) Obstructing another vehicle;
 - (c) In a designated fire route;
 - (d) In a designated area;
 - (e) Without a valid permit;
 - (f) In front of a driveway;
 - (g) In front of an entrance;
 - (h) Within 3 metres of a fire hydrant;
 - (i) Within 10 metres of a stop sign;
 - (j) Within 10 metres of an intersection;
 - (k) In the opposite direction of oncoming traffic;
 - (l) Outside of a marked space;
 - (m) In a manner that is angled to a highway;
 - (n) In excess of 12 hours;
 - (o) In a designated parking space;
 - (p) In a designated municipal EV charging station;
 - (q) In a loading zone;
 - (r) On or within a Town landscaped area;
 - (s) On or over a sidewalk;
 - (t) On or over a curb;
 - (u) On a walking path
 - (v) On a Town trail;
 - (w) On a boulevard;
 - (x) On a Town boardwalk;
 - (y) Where an official sign has been posted; or
 - (z) In a prohibited area.
- 4.2** No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle on a highway for the purpose of:
- (a) abandoning a vehicle;

- (b) washing or servicing a vehicle;
- (c) washing or servicing a recreational vehicle; or
- (d) displaying or selling any merchandise or product.

4.3 Notwithstanding the generality of Section 4.1 (m), angle parking is permitted on:

- (a) the East side of Muskoka Beach Rd. North of Winewood Ave. E.; and
- (b) the West side of Muskoka Beach Rd. at 1141 Muskoka Beach Rd.

4.4 Notwithstanding the generality of section 4.1 (n), no person shall park a motor vehicle within the Downtown Core, as identified in Schedule 'C' for a period longer than 3 hours.

5 MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS

5.1 Where an official sign has been posted, no person, shall park a vehicle in a municipal parking lot specified in Schedule 'D' for a period exceeding the posted time limit and/or restriction.

5.2 In general, no person shall park or stop a vehicle in a municipal lot or portions thereof for the purpose of:

- (a) washing or servicing a vehicle;
- (b) washing or servicing a recreational vehicle; or
- (c) displaying or selling any merchandise or product.

5.3 Unless otherwise permitted, no person shall park or stop a vehicle in a municipal lot:

- (a) in a prohibited area or space;
- (b) in designated municipal EV charging station;
- (c) in a designated boat trailer space;
- (d) in a designated bus space;
- (e) in a designated recreational vehicle space;
- (f) in excess of 4 hours;
- (g) in a driving lane;
- (h) across one or more parking spaces;
- (i) on any landscaped area;
- (j) so as to obstruct the flow of traffic;
- (k) so as to obstruct another previously parked vehicle;
- (l) stopped on a sidewalk, curb, walking path, trail, or boardwalk.

5.4 Contrary to Section 5.3, vehicles with attached snowmobile trailers may park overnight in parking lots designated as snowmobile staging areas between November 1st of one year to March 31st of the follow year.

6 OFFICIAL SIGNS AND DESIGNATED SPACES

6.1 Where an official sign has been posted, no person shall park or stop a motor vehicle:

- (a) on a Municipal Highway or portions thereof specified in Schedule 'A';
- (b) on a Municipal Highway or portions thereof specified in Schedule 'B'
- (c) on a Municipal Highway within the Downtown core for a period exceeding 3 hrs. as specified in Schedule 'C';
- (d) in a Municipal Parking lot indicating time limited parking as specified in Schedule 'D';
- (e) in a designated accessible parking space specified within Schedule 'E', without a valid accessible parking permit;
- (f) in a designated Bus Stand as specified within Schedule 'F';
- (g) in a designated Taxi Stand specified within Schedule 'G';
- (h) in a designated Ambulance Stand specified within Schedule 'H';
- (i) in a designated EV Charging Station specified within Schedule 'I';
- (j) within an area designated for:
 - i. Gravenhurst Fire Department
 - ii. Town of Gravenhurst Employee
 - iii. District of Muskoka Employee
 - iv. Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit (SMDHU);
- (k) in excess of 10 minutes; or
- (l) in a designated space.

6.2 The driver of a bus or taxicab shall not stop or park at any place other than at a bus or taxi stand unless legally engaged in the loading or unloading passengers.

7 TEMPORARY NO PARKING SIGNS

7.1 No person shall park a vehicle on a highway where a temporary no parking sign has been erected by an order made by the Manager of By-law Services or their designate. Such sign shall resemble the format specified in Schedule 'I'.

8 COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES

8.1 No person shall park a commercial vehicle on a highway in a residential zone.

8.2 The provisions of Section 8.1 do not apply to a Commercial Vehicle which attends at a residential premise for the purpose of and while engaged in a delivery and service.

9 LOADING/UNLOADING OF VEHICLES

9.1 Vehicles shall be loaded and unloaded from the side adjacent to the curb or edge of the roadway.

10 ACCESSIBLE PARKING PERMIT PARKING

- 10.1** No person shall:
- a) fail to display a valid accessible parking permit in accordance with the regulations;
 - b) fail or refuse to surrender an accessible parking permit in accordance with this Part or the regulations;

10.2 Designated accessible parking spaces, including designated accessible parking space located within private parking areas shall be assigned an official sign as per the Highway Traffic Act and any applicable Regulations.

11 MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT PERMIT PARKING LOTS

11.1 Where an authorized sign or signs have been erected, no person shall park a motor vehicle in any municipal parking lot specified in Schedule “G” attached hereto, without a valid permit being displayed in a conspicuous place.

11.2 Contrary to Section (11.1) a vehicle parked with an expired permit or parked in contravention of the terms and conditions of the permit is deemed to be parked illegally.

11.3 Vehicles displaying a valid Town of Gravenhurst Parking Lot Permit may park a motor vehicle overnight in parking lot #21 between May 1st to October 31st, for a maximum of 6 days.

11.4 Trailers displaying a valid Town of Gravenhurst Parking Lot Permit may park a recreational boat trailer in parking lot #22 between May 1st and October 31st.

11.5 Where a municipal parking lot closure permit has been issued, every person shall comply with the conditions set out in the special events approved application form and the conditions set out in the written authorization of the Manager of By-law Services. Failure to comply with the conditions of use will void and terminate such approval.

12 REMOVING AND IMPOUNDING VEHICLE

12.1 Where a vehicle is found to be in an emergent contravention or continued contravention with this By-law, the Manager of By-law Services or their designate, or the Director of Infrastructure or their designate may:

- (a) request a vehicle to be towed from its immediate location and relocated to an alternate location; or
- (b) request a vehicle to be towed from the immediate location in which the continued contravention occurs to an impound location as determined by the towing company.

12.2 A vehicle is deemed to be in contravention when:

- (a) in non-compliance with this By-law;
- (b) an emergency situation has been deemed by the:
 - i. Manager of By-law Services
 - ii. Director of Infrastructure Services or their designate, and/or
 - iii. Fire Chief or their designate.
- (c) a tow warning notification has been affixed to the vehicle by an Officer, or a member of the Town’s Infrastructure Services Department;
- (d) a vehicle obstructs the Town in their ability to complete required maintenance, repairs or emergency work by Town employees or contract workers;

12.3 Vehicles may be towed by order of an Ontario Provincial Police Constable where a statute other than a municipal by-law is being enforced. In these cases, the tow is performed under the authority of the Ontario Provincial Police Services.

13 ENFORCEMENT AND LIABILITY

13.1 All municipal law enforcement officers for the Town of Gravenhurst are hereby appointed to enforce the provisions of this By-law.

13.2 The Town or Person(s) acting on its behalf are not considered liable to compensate the Owner, Occupant or any other Person by reason of anything done by or on behalf of the Town or Person (s) acting on the Towns behalf, in the reasonable exercise of its powers.

14 PENALTIES

14.1 Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law, is guilty of an offence and upon conviction, is liable to a penalty as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act R.S.O. 1990, c. P33 (as amended from time to time).

15 IMPLEMENTATION OF OFFICIAL SIGNS

15.1 The Director of Infrastructure, or their designate, is hereby authorized and directed to obtain, erect, and maintain such official signs as are necessary to give effect the provisions of this By-law.

16 SEVERABILITY

16.1 Should any provision, or any part of a provision of this By-law be declared invalid or to be of no force and effect by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is the intent of Council that such provision, or part of a provision, shall be severed from this By-law, and every other provision of this By-law shall be applied and enforced in accordance with its terms to the extent possible according to law.

17 REPEAL

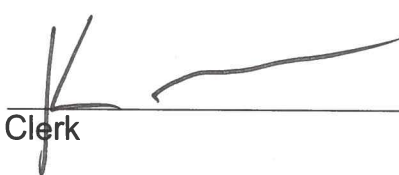
